WHY ROOTS EXISTS

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I thought it
was just me.

For years, I thought what I was experiencing was just part of leadership.

For much of my career, I thought I had to lead a certain way. I thought asking questions might make people think I wasn't prepared. I thought admitting I didn't have all the answers would make me look weak. I carried more because I believed I had to. I wasn't just representing myself. I was representing other women of color.

Even when I was the only woman of color, or one of only a few, I didn't always feel like I could say what I was really thinking. I questioned myself. I wondered if what I was experiencing was real. And because no one was talking about it, I thought it was just me.

Here's what I've come to understand one thing...

**Women of color don't begin their
careers doubting themselves**

The doubt is cultivated.

It doesn't happen because of one defining event.

It happens through the accumulation of repeated experiences over years.

Every microaggression.

Every time we have to prove ourselves again.

Every promotion that never comes.

Every salary inequity.

Every meeting where we're interrupted.

Every time we're told we're too much, too direct, too emotional, or not "executive" enough.

Together, they cultivate conditions that can disconnect us from our own leadership wisdom.

How Women Move Through ROOTS

You always have always had it inside of you.

The systems we've lived and worked in cultivated the conditions that caused you to question it.

RECOGNIZE

Examine the difference between what is true about you and what inequitable systems have caused you to question.

02

REFLECT

Reflect on what you've been carrying, where it came from, and whether it still serves you.

03

RECLAIM

Reclaim trust in yourself, your judgment, your voice, your power and your way of leading.

04

RECONNECT

Reconnect with yourself and with a community of women who understand what it means to lead in inequitable systems.

- Practical tools for navigating inequitable systems without losing themselves.
- A trusted community of accomplished women of color leaders.
